7th Annual Carolina Fall Nationals Information

1. Please - **No running of engines (on or off the track) before 7:00 AM and after 11:00 PM**, anytime during the event, this includes Friday and Saturday. No running of engines on Thanksgiving Day. If Sunday is needed, absolutely no running of engines (on or off the track) before 1:00PM. We have a strict curfew & appreciate everyone's cooperation.
2. NCQMA **WILL** be supplying track fuel for qualifying & racing. Prior to being fueled, all fuel tanks must be completely drained. Both bowls must be completely removed on the Honda engines. On Briggs Animal and World Formula engines, drain bowls using the bowl drain screw. NCQMA will NOT be supplying methanol for Lt. AA, Hvy. AA, or Jr. Half classes.
3. Items required for sign-ins/registration:
 - a. USAC Membership Card for Handler(s) & Driver(s)
 - b. If using your USAC free pass, the Completed Free Pass form
 - c. Driver's License required for Transponder Rental &/or RaceCeiver Rental
 - d. Online **Registration Confirmation** page.
 - e. Safety Inspection Sheet, if not already on file with NCQMA.Please come to sign-ins/registration prepared. This will help expedite the process.
4. Single-car qualifying order by class is based upon the online pre-registration timestamp through October 20th - First to register, last to qualify.
5. Transponders Required – Rentals Available
6. RaceCeivers Required – Rentals Available
7. When creating main event line-ups, the top 4 Jr./5 Sr. qualifiers will be inverted for each main, and all transfers will be straight up.
8. 20-minute Time Limits will be enforced for Lower Mains and Rookie Features.
9. Laps: 20 Lap A Mains for Rookies, 20 Lap Lower Mains/30 Lap A Mains for Juniors, 25 Lap Lower Mains/35 Lap A Mains for Seniors.
10. The USAC National Work Rule (2 laps) is in effect for this event.
11. NCQMA Carolina Fall National Single Car Qualifying Track Records are open for this event. (New for 2011)
12. Tech Inspections will apply – Fast Time/Track Record, Top (2), & a random pick from the A-Main. The random car will be announced at the completion of the race. Even if a DNF, be prepared to stay in tech impound in the event that your car is the random pick. NCQMA Tech Director has the authority to inspect any item at any time.
13. All A Main positions and Fast Time/Track Records will receive trophies. All participants will receive a goody bag and a Carolina Fall Nationals program.
14. Please visit www.ncqma.com and click on **Racing Info** to view NCQMA's Racing Rules, Tech Rules, and Safety Information.
15. Golf carts, four wheelers, and other motor operated vehicles will be allowed at this event; however, they may only be operated by someone with a valid driver's license. Failure to comply with this request, or observation of unsafe operation of the vehicle, will result in the confiscation of keys to the item until completion of event.
16. Bikes, scooters, green machines, etc. will be allowed at this event; however, these are NOT allowed on Friday or Saturday during racing. Everyone MUST wear a helmet & stay out of the fenced-in areas. Failure to comply with this request will result in the confiscation of the item until completion of event.
17. NCQMA will adhere to the USAC **Tire Treatment Policy**. USAC's "Dry Tire" Rule states that it is prohibited to use traction compounds or any substance that might alter the physical properties of a tire as supplied by the manufacturer. Tire cleaners/shiners, tire softeners, track adhesives, brake fluid, diesel fuel, etc. will not be permitted on the tires.
18. NCQMA's Engine Protest Policy, Fuel Testing Policy, and Tire Protest Policy will apply at this event.
