RESERVED PARKING FUNDRAISER

To help raise money for targeted facility improvements, NCQMA provides the opportunity for its members to pay for reserved parking/pit spots around the track. Parking diagram of the NCQMA facility is located on the website.

Renewals must be submitted AND paid for before February 2, 2025, to keep the existing spot.

- **NEW FOR 2025**, NCQMA will update its reserved parking policies to better accommodate our growing membership. Full-time club members may purchase parking spots equal to the number of cars they race as a family, with a maximum of four spots per family, regardless of the total cars raced. For example: If you race 3 three cars, you may purchase up to three spots. If you race five cars, you may purchase a maximum of four spots.
 - This policy applies only to members purchasing new spots or relocating for the 2025 season. Members who retain their current parking locations or have more spots than cars they race will be grandfathered in under the new rule. Additionally, members racing once car will be allowed to reserve up to two spots to allow for future growth.
- **NEW FOR 2025 – Premium Parking Eligibility** - Members with premium parking spots in 2025 **MUST** participate for points in the Championship Series (Saturday Series) to be eligible for renewal of those spots in the 2026 season. This requirement is mandatory.
- To retain your reserved parking spot(s) for the 2026 season, members **MUST** participate in a minimum of five **TOTAL** races from the Championship and/or Summer Series during the 2025 season. This Requirement represents 25% of the combined total races for both series.
- **Cost:** Premium Electric parking annual fee of **\$200.00**. Regular parking annual fee of **\$60**. Note: If you have 2 spots in premium parking, only one will be assessed the \$200.00 fee, entitling you to one electric plug-in, the other would remain at \$60.00. Unless you plan on using 2 electric plug ins then it would be an additional \$200.00. Max of 2 premium spots and only if available.
- **Premium Spots:** All trailers must be **UNPLUGGED** when they are not being occupied. If you leave the track without unplugging your trailer, it will be unplugged for you.
- Slides/awnings must be in on all Trailers/RVs and belongings picked up after the end of the race weekend.
- NCQMA is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged trailers, RVs, quarter midgets, or other member property.
- Members are responsible for moving any trailers/RVs in their parking spot before mowing at the track or must mow/trim their parking spot themselves. Members will be notified of when mowing is scheduled via the member chat. If you do not adhere to the parking spot maintenance requirements, you will be given a warning. Failure to maintain parking spot after your warning will result in a \$20 fine per offense that will be assessed at the following club race, and you will forfeit your right to renew that spot in the 2026 race season.
- Members are responsible for keeping their reserved parking/pit area clean and free of trash and debris.
- At the end of the 2025 race season, Trailers/RVs need to be moved off the grass and in designated “off season” parking area. Please contact the track director at the end of the season if you need “off season” parking.
- If you will not be using your designated parking space for more than 3 consecutive club race events, you will be asked to move your trailer to a designated area on-site so your pit space can be utilized by others racing.

Please make any request to purchase or change parking spaces to NCQMA Secretary by completing this form. All requests will be dated & you will be notified when a requested spot becomes available.

Zero Tolerance Policy

Effective January 2, 2025 (rev.)

Welcome to the North Carolina Quarter Midget Association. We are very proud of our facility, race track, club officials, members, and our family atmosphere. To ensure that your family's experience here is a positive one, we have instituted a "Zero Tolerance" Policy. Please review the violations below and make sure that everyone associated with your race team is familiar with them. This Policy will be strictly enforced and all decisions will be made by the NCQMA Board of Directors.

- ZTP form must be filed within 24 hours after the incident. Form may be submitted in person or emailed to any Board member. The form can be requested from a Board member or downloaded from the members only page on the NCQMA website.
- All information involving ZTP violations will be kept confidential between the Board and the parties involved.

	Violation/Action	Suspension Term*
1	Deliberately damaging, destroying or defacing NCQMA property and/or facility	Minimum (1) year plus cost of damages
2	Being under the influence of drugs or alcohol during racing conditions (i.e. from start of registration to tech completion)	Minimum (6) months - 180 days
3	Making any physical/verbal threat or contact to any person at the NCQMA facility (including drivers)	Minimum (1) month and up to 4 races
4	Throwing object in pit area or hot chute	Minimum (2) race weekends
5	Driver: Ignoring instructions from a track official	Race weekend - driver is done for the day and receives a DQ for that day
6	Handler: Ignoring instructions from a track official	Minimum (1) race weekend and handler is done for the day
7	Violating NCQMA rules and regulations - including, but not limited to, smoking in non-designated areas, violating NCQMA practice policy and cleaning tires without discarding debris.	Minimum (1) race weekend
8	Excessive yelling, comments or obscenities directed at a track official, handler or driver	Minimum (1) race weekend
9	Driver deliberately hitting another driver while on racetrack or in hot chute	Done for the day and DQ from class (driver only)
10	Driver making an offensive or derogatory hand gesture to track official	Done for the day and DQ from class (driver only)
11	Any disrespectful conduct toward the Chief Steward and/or race official	Done for the day and DQ from the class (driver and handler)
12	Any violation of the social media Policy for USAC .25 Members an Officials	Minimum (1) race weekend

***Suspension Terms**

- NCQMA Board can choose to suspend members, driver, and/or handler at Board's discretion. All Driver Suspensions are for that individual Driver only.
- All Suspension Terms begin the following race date on the schedule or as noted above. All Suspensions will be approved by the Board of Directors in attendance of the race event. Suspension Term will be determined by the Board Members in attendance on the date of violation. Suspension will begin at the date of violation. Suspension Term can carry over to next calendar year.
- Multiple violations/actions within a 12 month period will receive an extended suspension term.
- All Suspension Terms may be adjusted due to the severity of the violation by the Board of Directors. Written Notification of Suspension term will be sent, postmarked within 5 days of violation.

- Appeals must be received in writing within 7 days of receiving written suspension notification. Any DQ or suspension in reference to ZTP will not be allowed to be used as a "drop" in points.
- An appeals committee will be set up by the Board of Directors. This committee will consist of 3 NCQMA club members (in good standing with the club), a race day official, and a Board member.

To maintain its beauty and functionality, we have implemented three different, but related policies: the Work Detail, Demo Day and the Race Day Opening/Closing Policies. Please review the policies provided and the requirements below. Make sure everyone associated with your race team is familiar with them. These policies will be strictly enforced and all decisions by the NCQMA Board of Directors (BOD) are final.

Work Detail & Demo Day	
Requirement	Penalty
A representative from each NCQMA family must participate in at least one of the scheduled work detail dates or plan with the NCQMA Track Director to complete an alternative project.	The penalty for failure to participate in scheduled work detail is a \$100.00 fine that will be enforced after the last scheduled work detail day and not being eligible for end of year awards.
A representative from each NCQMA family must participate in at least one of the scheduled Demo Days.	The penalty for failure to participate in scheduled work detail is a \$100.00 fine that will be enforced after the last scheduled demo day and not being eligible for end of year awards.

Race day opening/closing duties will be selected by members via an online signup form. Each family must select a minimum of 2 opening or closing spots (2 openings, 2 closings or 1 opening and 1 closing). The number of required spots may change based on the number of active families each year. Members should report to the assigned captain at the start of duties to receive their tasks and after tasks have been completed to sign off. Failure to check in with the assigned captain at the conclusion of opening/closing duties may result in a penalty.

Race Day Opening/Closing	
Requirement	Penalty
Each NCQMA family will be required to participate in 2 race day opening or closing duties on a scheduled race day. This includes, but is not limited to, unlocking the scale house, putting out flags, fire extinguishers, & corner worker vests, blowing off the track and hot chute, distributing trash cans around facility, cleaning & restocking bathrooms, emptying trash cans, picking up the grounds, & any other duties assigned by captain.	The penalty for failure to participate in your 2 opening/closing duty dates is a \$100.00 fine that will be enforced at the last race date and not being eligible for end of year awards.
